## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1323

(First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Rudolph" and substitute "Rudolph, Holmes, Doory, Jameson, Krysiak, McHale, Miller, Minnick, Moe, Parrott, Trueschler, and Wood".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 4, after "operate" insert "or lease and operate"; strike beginning with "until" in line 8 down through "grid" in line 9 and substitute "for a certain period under certain circumstances"; and strike beginning with "requiring" in line 9 down through "time" in line 12 and substitute "altering the definition of eligible customer-generator to include certain customers that lease and operate certain generating facilities; authorizing the Public Service Commission to require certain customer-generators whose facilities are sized to produce energy in excess of a certain annual energy consumption to install a certain dual meter; requiring the Commission to develop a certain credit formula for certain customer-generators whose facilities are sized to produce energy in excess of a certain annual energy consumption".

## AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, in line 28, after "operates" insert "OR LEASES AND OPERATES".

On page 2, in line 23, strike "A" and substitute "EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION, A".

On page 3, in line 7, strike "A" and substitute "<u>AN ELIGIBLE</u>"; in line 11, strike "KILOWATTS PER HOUR" and substitute "<u>KILOWATT-HOUR</u>"; strike beginning with "THE" in line 11 down through "GRID" in line 12 and substitute "<u>:</u>

1. THE ELIGIBLE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR'S CONSUMPTION OF ELECTRICITY FROM THE GRID ELIMINATES THE CREDIT; OR

2. <u>THE 12-MONTH ACCRUAL PERIOD UNDER</u> SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH EXPIRES";

strike in their entirety lines 13 through 17, inclusive; after line 17, insert:

- "(G) FOR AN ELIGIBLE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR WHOSE FACILITY IS SIZED TO PRODUCE ENERGY IN EXCESS OF THE ELIGIBLE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR'S ANNUAL ENERGY CONSUMPTION, THE COMMISSION:
- (1) MAY REQUIRE THE ELIGIBLE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR TO INSTALL A DUAL METER THAT IS CAPABLE OF MEASURING THE FLOW OF ELECTRICITY IN TWO DIRECTIONS; AND
  - (2) SHALL DEVELOP A CREDIT FORMULA THAT:
- (I) EXCLUDES RECOVERY OF TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION COSTS; AND
- (II) PROVIDES THAT THE CREDIT MAY BE CALCULATED USING A METHOD OTHER THAN A KILOWATT-HOUR BASIS, INCLUDING A METHOD THAT ALLOWS A DOLLAR FOR DOLLAR OFFSET OF ELECTRICITY SUPPLIED BY THE GRID COMPARED TO ELECTRICITY GENERATED BY THE ELIGIBLE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR.";

and in line 18, strike "(g)" and substitute "(H)".
