AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 443
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after “Beverages -” insert “Class B (Inn) License and”; in line 3, after the first “of” insert “authorizing certain holders of a Class B (inn) license in Harford County to sell beer and wine for consumption off the premises under certain conditions;”; and line 13, after “1-102(a)(22)(iii)” insert “and 6-201(n)(7)(iv)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 25, insert:

“(7) (iv) 1. The holder of a 7-day special Class B (inn) license may sell, only in conjunction with a meal, alcoholic beverages to guests for consumption on the premises during the days and hours established for a Class B on-sale beer, wine and liquor license for Harford County under this article.

2. THE HOLDER OF A CLASS B (INN) LICENSE ISSUED AFTER MARCH 6, 2006, MAY SELL BEER AND WINE FROM THE DINING ROOM TO GUESTS FOR CONSUMPTION OFF THE PREMISES, IF THE HOLDER PREVIOUSLY HELD A CLASS B (RESTAURANT) LICENSE PERMITTING SALES OF BEER AND WINE FOR CONSUMPTION OFF THE PREMISES.”.
