## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 873

(Third Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "<u>certain</u>" in line 18 down through "<u>individuals</u>" in line 19 and substitute "<u>construction jobs for construction of any Red Line transit project to residents of certain legislative districts surrounding the Red Line transit project"; and in line 22, strike "<u>cochairs</u>" and substitute "<u>chair</u>".</u>

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 22, after "and" insert "should".

On page 3, strike line 4 in its entirety; and in lines 5, 6, 7, and 8, strike "(v)", "(vi)", "(vii)", and "(viii)", respectively, and substitute "(iv)", "(v)", "(vi)", and "(vii)", respectively.

On pages 4 and 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 15 on page 4 through line 16 on page 5, inclusive, and substitute:

- "(b) The Advisory Council consists of the following members:
  - (1) 10 members who:
    - (i) are appointed by the Maryland Transit Administrator from a list of:
      - 1. 10 names provided by the President of the Senate; and
      - <u>2.</u> <u>10 names provided by the Speaker of the House; and</u>
- (ii) are business owners, residents, service providers, or workers in the Red Line transit corridor within Baltimore City;

- (2) 3 members who are appointed by the Governor or, at the Governor's discretion, the Maryland Transit Administrator.
- (c) The Maryland Transit Administrator shall designate the chair of the Advisory Council from a list of:
- (1) 2 names provided by the President of the Senate from the 13 members appointed under subsection (b) of this section; and
- (2) 2 names provided by the Speaker of the House from the 13 members appointed under subsection (b) of this section.
  - (d) The term of a member of the Advisory Council shall be 1 year.
- (e) On resignation of a member, a new member shall be appointed according to the procedure used to appoint the resigning member.
- (f) Meetings of the Advisory Council shall be publicized and open to the public."; strike beginning with "consideration" in line 24 down through "(3)" in line 26; and after line 31, insert:
- "(iv) will be implemented after consideration of a full range of construction alternatives, including an underground rail option;".

On page 5, in line 32, strike "(iv)" and substitute "(v)".

On page 6, in lines 1 and 3, strike "(v)" and "(vi)", respectively, and substitute "(vi)" and "(vii)", respectively.
