AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 365, AS AMENDED
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Strike the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments(SB0365/034534/1) in its entirety.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1 of the bill, in line 3, strike “prohibiting” and substitute “requiring”; in the same line, strike “from being” and substitute “to be”; in line 5, after “date” insert “unless certain vaccines are not readily available or appropriate”; and strike beginning with “prohibiting” in line 5 down through “circumstances;” in line 14.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1 of the bill, strike in their entirety lines 25 through 28, inclusive, and substitute “ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2008, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE VACCINATED WITH A VACCINE THAT CONTAINS LESS THAN 1.25 MICROGRAMS OF MERCURY PER 0.5 MILLILITER DOSE UNLESS A VACCINE THAT MEETS THIS REQUIREMENT IS NOT READILY AVAILABLE OR APPROPRIATE.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On pages 2 and 3 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 1 on page 2 through line 2 on page 3, inclusive.
