  - (26) Fails to allow an inspection under § 8-6B-06(10) and (11) of this subtitle; [or]
  - (27) Fails to cooperate with a lawful investigation conducted by the Board;
  - (28) PRACTICES ELECTROLOGY WITHOUT A LICENSE BEFORE
