AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 666  
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 2 and 3 and substitute “Waters - Vessels - Penalties for Operating Recklessly”; and strike beginning with “establishing” in line 13 down through “vessels” in line 15 and substitute “altering the penalties for operating a vessel recklessly or in a certain manner in a certain location; altering the penalties for coming into a wharf or bathing shore recklessly or in a certain manner; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to operating a vessel in waters of the State”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 24, strike “another” and substitute “A PERSON”; and strike in their entirety lines 28 through 33, inclusive, and substitute:

“(B) (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS TITLE, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A)(1) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION:

(I) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR BOTH;

(II) FOR A SECOND OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$3,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS OR BOTH;  
AND

(III) FOR A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$4,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS OR BOTH.

(Over)

(2) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS TITLE, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A)(2) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION:

(I) FOR A FIRST OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,500 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 2 MONTHS OR BOTH; AND

(II) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,000 OR IMPRISONMENT OF NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

(C) IF A PERSON IS CHARGED WITH A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, THE COURT MAY FIND THE PERSON GUILTY OF ANY LESSER INCLUDED OFFENSE UNDER ANY SUBSECTION OF THIS SECTION.”.
