AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 297  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 32, after “program;” insert “prohibiting a person from requiring a licensed pharmacist who is employed by the person to obtain a certificate as a condition of employment; prohibiting a person from taking certain actions against a pharmacist solely as a result of the pharmacist’s refusal to obtain a certificate;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, after line 35, insert:

“(D) A PERSON MAY NOT:

(1) REQUIRE A LICENSED PHARMACIST WHO IS EMPLOYED BY THE PERSON TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AS A CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT; OR

(2) TERMINATE THE PHARMACIST’S EMPLOYMENT OR TAKE OTHER RECRIMINATORY ACTION AGAINST THE PHARMACIST SOLELY AS A RESULT OF THE PHARMACIST’S REFUSAL TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.”.
