AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 297  
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after “Government -” insert “State Commemorative Days -”; in the same line, after “Day” insert “and Charter Day”; in line 4, after “year” insert “; establishing the commemorative Charter Day to fall on a certain date of each year; and generally relating to State commemorative days”; and in line 7, after “13-405” insert “and 13-406”.

On page 2, in line 10, after “Maryland;” insert “and”

WHEREAS, Maryland should commemorate May 13 as Diamondback Terrapin Day; and

WHEREAS, On June 20, 1632, King Charles I granted the Charter of Maryland to Cecilius Calvert, the Second Lord Baltimore; and

WHEREAS, The granting of the Charter of Maryland on June 20, 1632 was the official beginning of the establishment of the great State of Maryland; and

WHEREAS, The citizens of Maryland should commemorate June 20 as Charter Day;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 16, insert:

“13-406.”

THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM JUNE 20 AS CHARTER DAY.”
