On page 1, in line 7, after "circumstances;" insert "<u>requiring the Secretary of State to</u> maintain a certain database or record under certain circumstances;"; after line 14, insert:

"BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Business Regulation

Section 6-404

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2004 Replacement Volume and 2005 Supplement)";

in line 24, strike the colon; in line 25, strike "(I)"; and in line 26, strike the semicolon and substitute a period.

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 11, inclusive; and after line 21, insert:

"Article - Business Regulation

6-404.

- (a) If the Secretary of State finds that an applicant for registration has complied with this title and the regulations adopted under it, the Secretary of State shall approve the application.
- (b) If the Secretary of State finds that an applicant for registration has not complied with this title and the regulations adopted under it applicable to registration, the Secretary of State:
 - (1) shall notify the applicant of the reasons the applicant is not in compliance; and
 - (2) for each month or part of a month that the applicant is not in compliance, may

assess a fee of \$25 30 days after a second notice is sent, by regular mail, to the applicant at the address on file with the Secretary of State.

- (C) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL MAINTAIN A DATABASE OR OTHER ELECTRONIC FILING RECORD THAT:
 - (1) IS ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC VIA THE INTERNET; AND
- (2) INCLUDES THE NAME OF EACH NONPROFIT FEDERATION OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, SOCIAL WELFARE, OR ENVIRONMENTAL AGENCIES OR ASSOCIATIONS THAT HAS BEEN REGISTERED UNDER THIS SECTION.".
