AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1577
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert “EMERGENCY BILL”; in line 6, after “of” insert “Liquor”; in line 7, after “located;” insert “repealing an exemption in Baltimore County for a Class A/Class 3 manufacturer’s (winery) license from any license quota established by the Baltimore County Board of Liquor License Commissioners for the election district in which the winery is located; making this Act an emergency measure;”; and after line 18, insert:

“BY repealing

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

Section 4-201(e)(3)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2005 Replacement Volume)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 13 and 14 and substitute:

“(e) [(3) Baltimore County wineries applying for a Class A/Class 3 license are exempt from quotas established by the Baltimore County Liquor Board as to the number of licenses in that election district.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.”.
