(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Pinsky" and substitute "Pinsky, Gladden, and Exum"; in line 4, strike "who" and substitute "that"; in line 5, strike "who"; and in line 8, after "circumstances;" insert "altering the definition of eligible customer-generator to include certain customers that lease and operate certain generating facilities; authorizing the Public Service Commission to require certain customer-generators whose facilities are sized to produce energy in excess of a certain annual energy consumption to install a certain dual meter; requiring the Commission to develop a certain credit formula for certain customer-generators whose facilities are sized to produce energy in excess of a certain annual energy consumption;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 23, after "operates" insert "OR LEASES AND OPERATES".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 22, strike "A" and substitute "EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION, A".

On page 3, in line 5, strike "A" and substitute "AN ELIGIBLE"; in line 10, after "THE" insert "ELIGIBLE"; and in line 14, after "(g)" insert "FOR AN ELIGIBLE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR WHOSE FACILITY IS SIZED TO PRODUCE ENERGY IN EXCESS OF THE ELIGIBLE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR'S ANNUAL ENERGY CONSUMPTION, THE COMMISSION:

(1) MAY REQUIRE THE ELIGIBLE CUSTOMER-GENERATOR TO INSTALL A DUAL METER THAT IS CAPABLE OF MEASURING THE FLOW OF ELECTRICITY IN TWO DIRECTIONS; AND

(2) SHALL DEVELOP A CREDIT FORMULA THAT:

(I) <u>EXCLUDES RECOVERY OF TRANSMISSION AND</u> DISTRIBUTION COSTS; AND

A METHOD OTHER THAN A KILOWATT BASIS, INCLUDING A METHOD THAT ALLOWS

A DOLLAR FOR DOLLAR OFFSET OF ELECTRICITY SUPPLIED BY THE GRID

COMPARED TO ELECTRICITY GENERATED BY THE ELIGIBLE

CUSTOMER-GENERATOR.
