AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 688  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Vaughn” and substitute “Vaughn, Benson, Kullen, Mandel, Pendergrass, and V. Turner”; in line 2, strike “Contract Minimum” and substitute “Reporting”; strike beginning with “establishing” in line 3 down through “Program” in line 6 and substitute “requiring certain units to submit certain reports to the Governor’s Office of Minority Affairs by certain dates; requiring the Governor’s Office of Minority Affairs to submit a report to the Board of Public Works and the Legislative Policy Committee on or before a certain date; and generally relating to reporting requirements under the Small Business Reserve Program”; in line 9, strike “11-101(x) and 14-501(c)” and substitute “11-101(x), 14-501(c), and 14-502”; and in line 14, strike “14-502” and substitute “14-505”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 and 3, strike beginning with “EACH” in line 34 on page 2 down through “FOR” in line 1 on page 3.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 7 through 10, inclusive, and substitute:

“14-505.

(a) Within 90 days after the end of each fiscal year, each designated procurement unit shall submit a report on the operation and effectiveness of the Small Business Reserve Program THAT COMPLIES WITH SUBSECTION (D)(2) OF THIS SECTION to the Board of Public Works.

(b) Within 60 days after receipt of all reports required under subsection (a) of this section, the Board of Public Works shall compile the information and report on THE OPERATION AND EFFECTIVENESS OF the entire Small Business Reserve Program to the Legislative Policy

(Over)

Committee, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article.

(C) (1) WITHIN 45 DAYS AFTER THE ENACTMENT OF THE BUDGET BILL BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, EACH DESIGNATED PROCUREMENT UNIT SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS THAT COMPLIES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(2) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1 FOLLOWING THE ENACTMENT OF THE BUDGET BILL, THE REPORT SHALL:

(I) STATE THE TOTAL DOLLAR VALUE OF PAYMENTS THE UNIT PLANS TO MAKE UNDER PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS;

(II) STATE THE TOTAL NUMBER AND THE DOLLAR VALUE OF PAYMENTS THE UNIT PLANS TO MAKE TO SMALL BUSINESSES UNDER DESIGNATED AND NONDESIGNATED SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE CONTRACTS, INCLUDING PURCHASE CARD PROCUREMENTS;

(III) INDICATE THE PERCENTAGE THOSE PAYMENTS TO SMALL BUSINESSES UNDER DESIGNATED AND NONDESIGNATED SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE CONTRACTS, INCLUDING PURCHASE CARD PROCUREMENTS, REPRESENT OF THE TOTAL PAYMENTS THE UNIT PLANS TO MAKE UNDER PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS; AND

(IV) CONTAIN OTHER INFORMATION AS REQUIRED BY THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.

(D) (1) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR, EACH UNIT SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS THAT COMPLIES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(2) FOR THE PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR, THE REPORT SHALL:

(I) STATE THE TOTAL NUMBER AND THE DOLLAR VALUE OF PAYMENTS THE UNIT MADE TO SMALL BUSINESSES UNDER DESIGNATED SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE CONTRACTS;

(II) STATE THE TOTAL NUMBER AND THE DOLLAR VALUE OF PAYMENTS THE UNIT MADE TO SMALL BUSINESSES UNDER NONDESIGNATED SMALL BUSINESS RESERVE CONTRACTS, INCLUDING PURCHASE CARD PROCUREMENTS;

(III) STATE THE TOTAL DOLLAR VALUE OF PAYMENTS THE UNIT MADE UNDER PROCUREMENT CONTRACTS; AND

(IV) CONTAIN OTHER SUCH INFORMATION AS REQUIRED BY THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS.

(E) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 OF EACH YEAR, THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF MINORITY AFFAIRS SHALL SUBMIT TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE LEGISLATIVE POLICY COMMITTEE A REPORT SUMMARIZING THE INFORMATION THE OFFICE RECEIVES UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.”;

in line 11, strike “3.” and substitute “2.”; and in line 12, strike “October 1, 2006” and substitute “June 1, 2006”.
