AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 168
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, strike “clarifying language” and substitute “requiring the Department of Transportation to report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 32, insert:

“(2) 5 CENTS FOR EACH ADDITIONAL POUND OF EXCESS WEIGHT OVER 1,000 POUNDS BUT LESS THAN 2,001 POUNDS;”;

in lines 33 and 35, strike “(2)” and “(3)”, respectively, and substitute “(3)” and “(4)”, respectively; and in line 34, strike “1,000” and substitute “2,000”.

On page 3, in lines 1 and 3, strike “(4)” and “(5)”, respectively, and substitute “(5)” and “(6)”, respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 21, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Transportation shall report to the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee and the House Environmental Matters Committee on or before December 1, 2007, on:

(1) the number of vehicles fined for weight violations occurring on the Chesapeake Bay Bridge or its appurtenant approaches between October 1, 2005 and September 30, 2006;

(2) the number of vehicles fined for weight violations occurring on the Chesapeake Bay

(Over)

Bridge or its appurtenant approaches between October 1, 2006 and September 30, 2007; and

(3) the number of vehicles fined for weight violations occurring at each other Maryland Transportation Authority facility during those time periods.”;

and in line 22, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
