AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 238

(Bill as Printed for Third Reading)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Education” and substitute “State Department of Education”; in the same line, strike “Program for New Teachers” and substitute “Programs - Guidelines”; and strike beginning with “establishing” in line 3 down through “Education” in line 11 and substitute “requiring the State Department of Education to develop certain guidelines for the establishment of comprehensive induction programs for new teachers employed by certain hard-to-staff schools; requiring the guidelines to include certain provisions concerning mentoring, professional development training and support, eligibility criteria, and certain other standards; requiring that funding for the development of the guidelines be as provided in the State budget; and generally relating to the State Department of Education and guidelines for comprehensive induction programs”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 21, strike “THERE IS A” and substitute “THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF”; and in the same line, strike “PROGRAM IN THE DEPARTMENT” and substitute “PROGRAMS”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 1, strike “COMPREHENSIVE INDUCTION PROGRAM” and substitute “GUIDELINES”; strike beginning with “, BUT” in line 1 down through “TO,” in line 2 and substitute “PROVISIONS CONCERNING”; in line 4, strike the second “AND”; strike beginning with “FORMAL” in line 5 down through “(1)” in line 9; in line 11, strike “(2)” and substitute “(4)”; in line 13, strike “(D)” and substitute “(C)”; and in the same line, strike “FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE INDUCTION PROGRAM” and substitute “TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE GUIDELINES REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION”.
