AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 259  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Methamphetamine Laboratories” and substitute “Controlled Dangerous Substances”; strike beginning with “manufactures” in line 3 down through “methamphetamine” in line 4 and substitute “violates certain provisions of law relating to the manufacture, distribution, dispensation, or possession of a controlled dangerous substance”; strike beginning with “certain” in line 4 down through the first “and” in line 5; and in line 6, strike “methamphetamine” and substitute “controlled dangerous substance”.

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 12 through 16, inclusive; and after line 16, insert:

“BY adding to

Article - Criminal Law

Section 5-610

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2002 Volume and 2005 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 5 through 7, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 5 on page 5 through line 14 on page 7, inclusive, and substitute:

“5-610.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES A PROVISION OF §§ 5-602 THROUGH 5-606 OF THIS SUBTITLE WITH RESPECT TO A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ALL COSTS OF CLEANING UP OR REMEDIATING LABORATORIES OR OTHER FACILITIES OPERATED FOR THE ILLEGAL MANUFACTURE OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE.”.
