- 1 Section 1 of this Act, a deputy sheriff of Baltimore County who is employed on or 2 before September 30, 2006:
- 3 (a) as a condition of continued employment shall provide to the Baltimore
- 4 County Sheriff on or before December 31, 2006, a copy of a baseline medical report
- 5 disclosing and describing any existing heart disease or hypertension from which the
- 6 deputy sheriff may be suffering; and
- 7 (b) is entitled to the presumption under § 9-503(b)(2) of the Labor and
- 8 Employment Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, only to the extent that the
- 9 individual suffers from heart disease or hypertension that is more severe than the
- 10 individual's heart disease or hypertension condition existing as of the date of the
- 11 medical report provided under paragraph (a) of this section.
