16 (b) (7) THE FOUNDATION MAY APPROVE A LANDOWNER'S REQUEST TO
17 RELOCATE THE SITE OF AN EXISTING DWELLING TO ANOTHER LOCATION ON A FARM
18 SUBJECT TO AN EASEMENT OR DISTRICT AGREEMENT, PROVIDED:

19 (I) THE NEW LOCATION DOES NOT INTERFERE WITH ANY 20 AGRICULTURAL USE; AND

UNOFFICIAL COPY OF HOUSE BILL 90

(II) THE EXISTING DWELLING AT THE CURRENT LOCATION, WITH
 THE FOUNDATION'S APPROVAL, IS EITHER DEMOLISHED OR PERMANENTLY
