12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (1) The State's Attorney's salary is [~~\$91,100~~] \$98,000.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §

19 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to

20 the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Somerset County in office on

21 the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or

22 compensation of the State's Attorney for Somerset County shall take effect at the

23 beginning of the next following term of office.

24 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

25 October 1, 2006.
