CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Somerset County - Orphans' Court Judges - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the salaries of the Chief Judge and associate judges of
 4 the Orphans' Court for Somerset County; providing that this Act does not apply
 5 to the salary or compensation of the incumbent Chief Judge or associate judges
 6 of the Orphans' Court for Somerset County; and generally relating to Orphans'
 7 Court judges in Somerset County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Estates and Trusts**

16 2-108.

17 (t) (1) The Chief Judge of the Court for Somerset County shall receive an
 18 annual salary of [\$1,900] \$3,800 to be paid quarterly.

19 (2) Each of the associate judges of the Court for Somerset County shall
 20 receive an annual salary of [\$1,700] \$3,400 to be paid quarterly.

1 (3) Each judge shall also receive a daily allowance for traveling expenses
2 of \$34.50 for every day's attendance upon the sessions of the Court.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
4 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
5 the salary or compensation of the Chief Judge and associate judges of the Orphans'
6 Court for Somerset County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions
7 of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Chief Judge and associate
8 judges of the Orphans' Court of Somerset County shall take effect at the beginning of
9 the next following term of office.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2006.
