10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
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Article - Election Law

14 (a) For each individual who seeks to vote, an election judge, in accordance 15 with instructions provided by the local board, shall:

16 (1) locate the individual's name in the precinct register and locate the
17 preprinted voting authority card and then authorize the individual to vote a regular
18 ballot;

19(2)(i)if the individual's name is not found on the precinct register,20search the inactive list and if the name is found, authorize the individual to vote a21regular ballot; or

22 (ii) if the individual's name is not on the inactive list, refer the 23 individual for provisional ballot voting under § 9-404 of this article;

24 (3) establish the identity of the voter by [requesting the voter to state
25 the month and day of the voter's birth and comparing the response to the information
