3 (a) In this section, "Program" means the Maryland Adult External High
4 School Program established for the citizens of Maryland under regulations adopted by
5 the State Board.

6 (b) According to these regulations:

7 (1) The State Board recognizes demonstrated competencies in adults,
8 regardless of whether these competencies were acquired in a formal school setting;
9 and

10 (2) In response to this recognition of competencies, the Department 11 provides alternative requirements and methods of obtaining a Maryland high school 12 diploma.

(c) (1) Because the Program is a valuable service that is provided to the
citizens of Maryland, for each [of] fiscal [years 1998 through 2006] YEAR the
Governor shall include in the annual budget bill submitted to the General Assembly,
including any proposed supplemental budget, a General Fund appropriation for the
Maryland Adult External High School Program in an amount not less than the
amount of the Governor's General Fund appropriation for the Program in fiscal year
[1996] 2006.

20 (2) For each [of] fiscal [years 1998 through 2006] YEAR the Governor 21 shall include federal funds, to the extent available, for the Program in an amount not

21 shall include lederal lunds, to the extent available, for the Program in an amount not 22 less than the amount of the Governor's federal fund appropriation for the Program in

23 fiscal year [1996] 2006.

24 [(d) During fiscal year 2006, in order to assess the effectiveness of the 25 Program, the State Board shall conduct an evaluation of the Program.

(e) The State Board shall report to the General Assembly on or before
December 31, 2005, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on
the results of the evaluation of the Program.]
