- 14 (C) "CBE STEM CELL" MEANS A CORD-BLOOD-DERIVED-EMBRYONIC-LIKE 15 STEM CELL.
- 16 (D) "CORD BLOOD" MEANS BLOOD THAT IS DERIVED FROM AN UMBILICAL 17 CORD.
- 18 (E) "DIFFERENTIATION" MEANS THE PROCESS BY WHICH A PARTIALLY

- 28 FOR BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH USING ADULT OR CBE STEM CELLS.
- 29 (2) THE STATE MAY RECOVER AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT OF
- 30 STATE FUNDS DISBURSED FOR THE RESEARCH PROJECT, TOGETHER WITH ALL
- 31 COSTS AND REASONABLE ATTORNEYS' FEES INCURRED BY THE STATE IN THE
