- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (a-1) (1) (I) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
- 16 SUBSECTION, A Class A, B, or D beer license, beer and wine license, or beer, wine and
- 17 liquor license, except by way of renewal, may not be granted, transferred, or issued to,
- 18 or for use in conjunction with, or upon the premises of any business establishment of
- 19 the type commonly known as chain stores, supermarkets, or discount houses.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 2006.
