- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

	(a) (3) (i) The Secretary shall provide on request, to any person uthorized by regulation adopted under this subtitle, a commemorative birth ertificate.
6 7	(ii) The Department shall set a fee for the commemorative birth ertificate.

- 5 (H) THE TREASURER SHALL INVEST AND REINVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND 6 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.
