24 25	(3) The construction OR MODIFICATION of a generating station constructed by a person that is required to obtain a certificate of public convenience and necessity [under §§ 7-207 and 7-208] IN ACCORDANCE WITH §§ 7-205, 7-207, AND 7-208 of the Public Utility Companies Article and regulations adopted by the Public Service Commission;
