## 1 **Article - Business Regulation** 2 4-401. In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated. 3 (a) 4 "Contact" means a communication, direct or indirect, between an athlete (e) 5 agent and a student-athlete OR ANYONE ASSOCIATED WITH THE 6 STUDENT-ATHLETE, INCLUDING THE STUDENT-ATHLETE'S PARENT, BLOOD 7 RELATIVE, OR LEGAL GUARDIAN, to recruit or solicit the student-athlete to enter into 8 an agency contract. 9 4-413. 10 (b) An athlete agent may not intentionally: 11 (1) initiate contact with a student-athlete OR ANY INDIVIDUAL 12 ASSOCIATED WITH THE STUDENT-ATHLETE, INCLUDING THE STUDENT-ATHLETE'S 13 PARENT, BLOOD RELATIVE, OR LEGAL GUARDIAN, unless licensed under this subtitle; 14 refuse or fail to retain or permit inspection of the records required to 15 be retained by § 4-412 of this subtitle; fail to obtain a license when required by § 4-403 of this subtitle; 16 (3) 17 (4) provide materially false or misleading information in an application 18 for a license or renewal of a license; 19 (5) predate or postdate an agency contract; or 20 (6)fail to notify a student-athlete before the student-athlete signs or 21 otherwise authenticates an agency contract for a particular sport that the signing or 22 authentication may make the student-athlete ineligible to participate as a 23 student-athlete in that sport. 24 SECTION 2.
