A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Barbers and State Board of Cosmetologists - Reinstatement**  
3 **of Expired Permits**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Barbers and the State Board of  
5 Cosmetologists to reinstate permits expired for a certain period of time if the  
6 permit holder meets certain requirements; authorizing the Boards to establish  
7 certain fees; specifying reinstatement procedures for certain expired permits;  
8 and generally relating to the State Board of Barbers and the State Board of  
9 Cosmetologists.

10 BY adding to

11 Article - Business Occupations and Professions  
12 Section 4-506.1 and 5-506.1  
13 Annotated Code of Maryland  
14 (2004 Replacement Volume and 2005 Supplement)

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Business Occupations and Professions**

18 4-506.1.

19 (A) THE BOARD MAY REINSTATE A BARBERSHOP PERMIT THAT HAS EXPIRED  
20 IF THE OWNER OF THE BARBERSHOP:

21 (1) APPLIES TO THE BOARD FOR REINSTATEMENT WITHIN 45 DAYS  
22 AFTER THE PERMIT EXPIRES;

23 (2) OTHERWISE MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 4-506(C) OF THIS  
24 SUBTITLE; AND

25 (3) PAYS TO THE BOARD A REINSTATEMENT FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE  
26 BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 4-206 OF THIS TITLE, IN ADDITION TO THE RENEWAL  
27 FEE REQUIRED UNDER § 4-506(C)(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

1 (B) IF AN OWNER OF A BARBERSHOP HAS FAILED TO RENEW A BARBERSHOP  
2 PERMIT AND APPLIES TO THE BOARD FOR REINSTATEMENT MORE THAN 45 DAYS  
3 AFTER THE PERMIT HAS EXPIRED, THE BOARD SHALL REINSTATE THE PERMIT ONLY  
4 IF THE BARBERSHOP OWNER QUALIFIES FOR A BARBERSHOP PERMIT IN  
5 ACCORDANCE WITH §§ 4-502 AND 4-503 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

6 5-506.1.

7 (A) THE BOARD MAY REINSTATE A BEAUTY SALON PERMIT THAT HAS  
8 EXPIRED IF THE OWNER OF THE SALON:

9 (1) APPLIES TO THE BOARD FOR REINSTATEMENT WITHIN 45 DAYS  
10 AFTER THE PERMIT EXPIRES;

11 (2) OTHERWISE MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 5-506(C) OF THIS  
12 SUBTITLE; AND

13 (3) PAYS TO THE BOARD A REINSTATEMENT FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE  
14 BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 5-205 OF THIS TITLE, IN ADDITION TO THE RENEWAL  
15 FEE REQUIRED UNDER § 5-506(C)(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

16 (B) IF AN OWNER OF A SALON HAS FAILED TO RENEW A BEAUTY SALON  
17 PERMIT AND APPLIES TO THE BOARD FOR REINSTATEMENT MORE THAN 45 DAYS  
18 AFTER THE PERMIT HAS EXPIRED, THE BOARD SHALL REINSTATE THE PERMIT ONLY  
19 IF THE SALON OWNER QUALIFIES FOR A BEAUTY SALON PERMIT IN ACCORDANCE  
20 WITH §§ 5-502 AND 5-503 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
22 effect October 1, 2006.
