1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Allegany County Agricultural Expo and Fairgrounds Loan of 1999**

3 FOR the purpose of amending the Allegany County Agricultural Expo and
4 Fairgrounds Loan of 1999 to repeal a requirement that the grantee grant and
5 convey a certain easement to the Maryland Historical Trust; and generally
6 relating to the Allegany County Agricultural Expo and Fairgrounds Loan of
7 1999.

9 Chapter 175 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1999

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Chapter 175 of the Acts of 1999**

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That:

19 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
20 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
21 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
22 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the

1 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
2 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of County Commissioners of
3 Allegany County (referred to hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning,
4 design, construction, and capital equipping of the Allegany County fairgrounds of
5 three connected pavilion buildings that would contain the Allegany County
6 Agricultural Expo offices, exhibition areas, rest rooms, and showers and a separate
7 expo building that would contain a year-round activity area with a catering kitchen
8 and rest rooms that could be used for meetings, conventions, banquets, trade shows,
9 and similar events.

10 [(6) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey
11 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
12 its interest:

13 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
14 and

15 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
16 structures.

17 (b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust
18 and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.]

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 June 1, 2006.
