18 19	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

	(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, if the title or interest of an owner in a registered vehicle passes to another person other than by voluntary transfer:
25	(1) The registration of the vehicle expires; and

26 (2) The vehicle may not be driven on a highway until the person entitled 27 to possession of the vehicle applies for and obtains a new registration of the vehicle.

- 1 (b) [However, the] THE person entitled to possession of the vehicle, or his
- 2 authorized representative, may drive the vehicle on highways in this State for a
- 3 distance of not more than 200 miles, but only from the place that the person or his
- 4 authorized representative obtained possession of the vehicle to the person's place of
- 5 business, residence, or other place where the vehicle is to be kept.
