A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Lottery for Schools Act of 2006

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain lottery proceeds to

4 certain public school systems for certain purposes; specifying that certain lottery

5 proceeds be distributed to the General Fund of the State and used to help fund

6 a certain statewide program for public education; specifying that the proceeds

7 distributed under this Act to a public school system are intended to provide

8 additional revenue for public school systems and may not supplant other

9 revenue distributed to public school systems; making stylistic changes; defining 10 a certain term; and generally relating to the distribution of lottery proceeds to

11 public school systems in the State and to the General Fund of the State.

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 (1) on a pro rata basis for the daily and nondaily State lottery games, the 2 expenses of administering and operating the State lottery, as authorized under this 3 subtitle and the State budget; and

10 MAY NOT SUPPLANT ANY OTHER REVENUE DISTRIBUTED TO PUBLIC SCHOOL
11 SYSTEMS.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 2006.

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
