BUYER SHOULD CONTACT THE PUBLIC AFFAIRS OFFICE OF THE NEAREST MILITARY INSTALLATION TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE PROPERTY MAY BE IMPACTED BY TESTING OR OPERATIONS AT THE INSTALLATION."
