1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Horse Industry Board - Sunset Extension and Program**
 3 **Evaluation**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the inspection schedule for stables licensed by the
 5 Maryland Horse Industry Board from an annual to biennial schedule;
 6 continuing the Board in accordance with the provisions of the Maryland
 7 Program Evaluation Act (Sunset Law) by extending to a certain date the
 8 termination provisions relating to statutory and regulatory authority of the
 9 Board; requiring that an evaluation of the Board and the statutes and
 10 regulations that relate to the Board be performed on or before a certain date;
 11 repealing the abrogation of certain statutes relating to the Board; requiring the
 12 Board to submit certain reports to certain committees of the General Assembly
 13 by certain dates; and generally relating to the Maryland Horse Industry Board.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Agriculture**

17 2-710.

18 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a person may not engage in
19 the business of operating or maintaining any horse riding stable unless the person
20 has received a license and a certificate issued by the Board.

21 (b) This section does not apply to a holder of a livestock dealer's or livestock
22 market license issued under Title 3, Subtitle 3 of this article. However, a holder of a
23 livestock dealer's or livestock market license shall comply with the other provisions of
24 this subtitle.

25 2-713.

26 (a) Each horse riding stable licensed under this subtitle shall be inspected at
27 least [annually] EVERY 2 YEARS.

28 2-719.

29 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program
30 Evaluation Act, the provisions of this subtitle and of any rule or regulation adopted
31 under this subtitle shall terminate and be of no effect after [July 1, 2006] JULY 1,
32 2016.

3 (a) On or before December 15 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a
4 governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a
5 preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this
6 section.

7 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (a) of this section, on or before
8 the evaluation date for the following governmental activities or units, an evaluation
9 shall be made of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and
10 regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units:

11 (31) Horse Industry Board, Maryland (§ 2-701 of the Agriculture Article:
12 [July 1, 2005] JULY 1, 2015);

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
15 effect July 1, 2002. [It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of
16 June 30, 2007, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall
17 be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Horse
19 Industry Board shall report to the Senate Finance Committee, the Senate Education,
20 Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee, the House Ways and Means
21 Committee, and the House Environmental Matters Committee on or before December
22 31, 2006, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, regarding the
23 administrative penalties the Board is authorized to impose under § 2-718(b) of the
24 Agriculture Article, including in the report any regulations that have been adopted
25 under § 2-718(b) of the Agriculture Article and a discussion of the number and
26 amount of administrative penalties levied under § 2-718(b) of the Agriculture Article.

27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Horse
28 Industry Board shall report to the Senate Finance Committee, the Senate Education,
29 Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee, the House Ways and Means
30 Committee, and the House Environmental Matters Committee on or before October 1,
31 2006, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the
32 implementation of the recommendations of the Department of Legislative Services
33 contained in the sunset evaluation report dated October 2004.

34 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
35 effect July 1, 2006.
