	(I) SEVEN MEMBERS WHO SHALL RESIDE IN AND BE ELECTED, RESPECTIVELY, BY THE ELIGIBLE VOTERS OF EACH OF THE SEVEN COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS; AND
