3 (C) THE MUSIC PLAYED ON A LICENSED PREMISES MAY NOT EXCEED THE
4 NOISE LEVEL LIMITS UNDER § ZS 1-327 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF
5 WORCESTER COUNTY OR THE NOISE LEVEL LIMITS OF THE MUNICIPAL
6 CORPORATION IN WHICH THE LICENSED PREMISES IS LOCATED.

7 (D) IF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS FINDS A LICENSED
8 PREMISES IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD MAY:

9 (1) REQUIRE THE LICENSEE TO ALTER THE TIME THAT THE MUSIC IS
10 PLAYED;

11 (2) REQUIRE THE LICENSEE TO REDUCE THE NOISE LEVEL; OR

12 (3) ~~SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE LICENSE~~ TAKE ANY OTHER ACTION THAT
13 IS AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
