- 16 the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Baltimore County in office on the effective
- 17 date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation
- 18 of the Sheriff of Baltimore County shall take effect at the beginning of the next
- 19 following term of office.
