3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Public Service Commission to examine all 4 accounts, books, and records that the Commission determines necessary to 5 perform its duties under certain provisions of law, including the accounts, books, 6 and records of a public service company, a parent of a public service company, an 7 affiliate of a public service company, and an affiliate of a parent of a public 8 service company; defining certain terms; providing that the powers and 9 authority conferred by this Act are supplemental to other powers of the 10 Commission; and generally relating to the examination of accounts, books, and 11 records by the Public Service Commission.
