3 (2) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2006, TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED IN THE STATE

14 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is not intended 15 and shall not be construed to reduce the number of positions in any office of a clerk of 16 the circuit court.

17 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 July 1, 2006.
