BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article - Education** 17 6-401. "Public school employee" means a certificated professional individual 18 (d) (1) 19 who is employed by a public school employer or an individual of equivalent status in 20 Baltimore City, except for a county superintendent or an individual designated by the 21 public school employer to act in a negotiating capacity as provided in § 6-408(b) of 22 this subtitle.
