14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (c) and (d) of this section, the
governing body of each county shall establish a mental health advisory committee.

20 (b) The purpose of a mental health advisory committee shall be to serve as 21 advocate for a comprehensive mental health system for persons of all ages.

(c) The governing bodies of two or more counties may establish, by agreement,
an intercounty mental health advisory committee if:

24 (1) The population of one of the counties is too small to warrant the 25 establishment of a mental health advisory committee for that county; and
