- 22 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 23 INDICATED.
- 24 (B) (1) "CORRECTIONAL UNIT" MEANS A UNIT OF STATE OR LOCAL
- 25 GOVERNMENT THAT IS DIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CARE, CUSTODY, AND
- 26 CONTROL OF INDIVIDUALS COMMITTED TO THE CUSTODY OF THE UNIT FOR THE

- 1 COMMISSION OR ALLEGED COMMISSION OF A CRIME OR AN ACT THAT WOULD BE A 2 CRIME IF COMMITTED BY AN ADULT.
- 3 (2) "CORRECTIONAL UNIT" INCLUDES:
- 4 (I) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL
- 5 SERVICES;
- 6 (II) THE DEPARTMENT OF JUVENILE SERVICES; AND
- 7 (III) THE OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF OF A COUNTY OR OTHER UNIT OF
- 8 GOVERNMENT WITH RESPONSIBILITY FOR OPERATING A LOCAL CORRECTIONAL
- 9 FACILITY OR COUNTY DETENTION CENTER.
- 10 (C) "MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT" MEANS AN AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH AND
- 11 CARRY OUT A PLAN TO ASSIST IN PROVIDING TEMPORARY SERVICES TO ALLEVIATE
- 12 AN EMERGENCY SITUATION AT A FACILITY OPERATED BY A CORRECTIONAL UNIT.

- 14 THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE LIBERALLY CONSTRUED IN ORDER TO EFFECT ITS

- 18 (A) A CORRECTIONAL UNIT MAY ENTER INTO OR RENEW A MUTUAL AID
- 19 AGREEMENT WITH ANY OTHER CORRECTIONAL UNIT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS

- 21 (B) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A MUTUAL AID
- 22 AGREEMENT MAY PROVIDE THAT A PARTY THAT REQUESTS ASSISTANCE UNDER THE
- 23 MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT INDEMNIFIES AND HOLDS HARMLESS A PARTY THAT
- 24 PROVIDES ASSISTANCE UNDER THE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FROM ANY CLAIM BY
- 25 A THIRD PARTY FOR PROPERTY DAMAGE, PERSONAL INJURY, OR WRONGFUL DEATH
- 26 THAT ARISES OUT OF THE MUTUAL AID ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING TRAVEL, OF THE
- 27 PARTY THAT PROVIDES ASSISTANCE OUTSIDE OF THE PARTY'S OWN JURISDICTION.
- 28 (2) THE PARTY THAT REQUESTS ASSISTANCE NEED NOT INDEMNIFY
- 29 THE PARTY THAT PROVIDES ASSISTANCE IF:
- 30 (I) THE PARTY THAT PROVIDES ASSISTANCE DOES NOT
- 31 COOPERATE IN DEFENDING AGAINST A CLAIM MADE BY A THIRD PARTY; OR
- 32 (II) THE CLAIM BY A THIRD PARTY ARISES OUT OF A MALICIOUS
- 33 ACT OF THE PARTY THAT PROVIDES ASSISTANCE.
- 34 (C) EACH MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT SHALL PROVIDE THAT EACH PARTY TO
- 35 THE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT SHALL WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS AGAINST ALL
- 36 OTHER PARTIES TO THE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT IF THE CLAIM ARISES OUT OF THE

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- 1 ACTIVITIES OF A PARTY THAT OCCUR OUTSIDE ITS OWN JURISDICTION UNDER THE
- 2 MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT.

- 4 AT THE REQUEST OF THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL
- 5 SERVICES, THE SECRETARY OF JUVENILE SERVICES, OR THE HEAD OF ANY
- 6 CORRECTIONAL UNIT, A STAFF PERSON OF A CORRECTIONAL UNIT WHO HAS BEEN
- 7 TRAINED AND CERTIFIED BY THE CORRECTIONAL TRAINING COMMISSION IN THE
- 8 CARE, CUSTODY, AND CONTROL OF INDIVIDUALS MAY FUNCTION AT THE LOCATION
- 9 IN NEED UNDER A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT.

- 11 FOR THE PURPOSE OF A WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW OR BENEFIT OR
- 12 OTHER LAW OR BENEFIT THAT WOULD APPLY OR ACCRUE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS
- 13 PERFORMING A SERVICE ANYWHERE FOR A CORRECTIONAL UNIT UNDER A MUTUAL
- 14 AID AGREEMENT, THE INDIVIDUAL IS CONSIDERED TO HAVE PERFORMED THAT
- 15 SERVICE IN THE COURSE OF EMPLOYMENT AND IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

- 17 NECESSARY EXPENDITURES FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE
- 18 MADE OUT OF ANY STATE OR LOCAL APPROPRIATIONS USUALLY AVAILABLE TO A
