1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - Community Development Authorities**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Frederick County to
4 create community development authorities throughout the county by repealing
5 certain geographical restrictions; authorizing the county commissioners to levy
6 certain taxes or fees and issue certain bonds or other obligations without
7 geographical restriction; and generally relating to community development
8 authorities in Frederick County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 11 - Frederick County**

22 2-7-125.

1 (B) (1) For the purposes stated under paragraph (2) of this subsection, and
2 subject to the provisions of this section, the county commissioners may:

3 (I) Create a community development authority;

4 (II) Levy ad valorem or special taxes or fees; and

5 (III) Issue bonds and other obligations.

6 [(R) This section shall apply only in:

7 (1) The Lake Linganore Planned Unit Development (PUD) Area; and

8 (2) That land located in the Urbana (No. 7) Election District that was
9 zoned:

10 (I) Planned Unit Development (PUD) or Office, Research,
11 Industrial (ORI) as of January 1, 1997; or

12 (II) Village Center (VC) or General Commercial (GC) and located in
13 Parcel 68 on Frederick County Tax Map 96 (Maryland SDAT account number
14 07-0200595).]

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 July 1, 2006.
