BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article 7 - Carroll County** 17 18 3-101. 19 The Board of County Commissioners for Carroll County consists of five (a) 20 Commissioners to be elected by Commissioner District.

21 (b) Each County Commissioner is entitled to:

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1 (1) A salary of \$45,000 a year; and

2 (2) An allowance for expenses incurred in the performance of the duties 3 of that office, as provided in the county budget.

4 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL IS ELIGIBLE TO SERVE AS A COUNTY COMMISSIONER IF, 5 ON THE DATE OF THE ELECTION:

6 (1) THE INDIVIDUAL IS AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE;

7 (2) THE INDIVIDUAL IS A RESIDENT OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND 8 CARROLL COUNTY;

9 (3) THE INDIVIDUAL HAS RESIDED IN CARROLL COUNTY FOR AT LEAST 1 10 YEAR PRECEDING THE DATE OF THE ELECTION; AND

(4) (I) IF THE DISTRICT TO WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN
 ELECTED TO REPRESENT HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS PRIOR
 TO THE ELECTION, THE INDIVIDUAL HAS RESIDED IN THE DISTRICT FOR AT LEAST 6
 MONTHS; OR

(II) IF THE DISTRICT TO WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL HAS BEEN
 ELECTED TO REPRESENT HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR LESS THAN 6 MONTHS PRIOR
 TO THE ELECTION, THE INDIVIDUAL HAS RESIDED IN THE DISTRICT FOR AS LONG AS
 IT HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED.
