- 18 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, ON ELECTION DAY AT
- 19 A POLLING SITE OR WITHIN AN AREA SURROUNDING THE POLLING SITE PRESCRIBED
- 20 BY THE STATE BOARD, a person may not attire or equip an individual, or permit an
- 21 individual to be attired or equipped, in a manner which creates the appearance that
- 22 the individual is performing an official or governmental function in connection with
- 23 an election, including:
- 24 (1) wearing a public or private law enforcement or security guard
- 25 uniform:

- 1 (3) except as required by law or by regulation adopted by the State Board 2 in connection with ballot security activities, carrying or displaying a gun or badge 3 within 100 feet of a polling site on election day.
- 4 (b) (1) A law enforcement officer or security guard who is on duty or 5 traveling to or from duty may vote while wearing a uniform.
- 6 (2) a law enforcement officer who is performing an official governmental 7 function may wear a uniform at a polling site.
- 8 (c) A person who violates this section is subject to the civil penalty specified 9 under § 16-1002 of this title.
