- 4 vehicles manufactured in a certain model year or later; defining the term
- 5 "antique motor vehicle"; providing for the registration of antique motor vehicles;
- 6 establishing a <u>one-time</u> registration fee <u>for vehicles manufactured at least a</u>
- 7 certain number of years prior to the current model year; providing that the
- 8 registration of an antique a certain motor vehicle is not transferable; requiring
- 9 an application for registration as an antique motor vehicle to contain certain
- 10 certifications; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue a special

For EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (I) OF THIS SECTION, FOR each 5 6 Class L (historic) vehicle, the annual registration fee is \$25.50. 7 (e) In applying for registration of a historic motor vehicle under this section, 8 the owner of the vehicle shall submit with the application a certification that the vehicle for which the application is made: 10 (1) Will be maintained for use in exhibitions, club activities, parades, 11 tours, occasional transportation, and similar uses; and 12 (2) Will not be used: For general daily transportation; or 13 (i) 14 Primarily for the transportation of passengers or property on (ii) 15 highways.
