## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - Firefighting, Rescue, and Ambulance Services**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of County Commissioners of Frederick  
4 County to use certain funds for firefighting, rescue, or ambulance services;  
5 authorizing the Board to appropriate the funds from the proceeds of a certain  
6 special district tax and other sources; and generally relating to firefighting,  
7 rescue, and ambulance services in Frederick County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
9 The Public Local Laws of Frederick County  
10 Section 2-8-6(a)(1) and (2)  
11 Article 11 - Public Local Laws of Maryland  
12 (2004 Edition and June 2005 Supplement, as amended)

13 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
14 The Public Local Laws of Frederick County  
15 Section 2-8-6(e)(3)  
16 Article 11 - Public Local Laws of Maryland  
17 (2004 Edition and June 2005 Supplement, as amended)

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 11 - Frederick County**

21 2-8-6.

22 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

23 (2) "Fire and rescue services" means firefighting, rescue, or ambulance  
24 services.25 (e) (3) The board of county commissioners may appropriate from the  
26 proceeds of the special district tax, and from other sources, funds to be used within  
27 the district for[:

- 1 (i) Compensating fire and rescue personnel;
- 2 (ii) Training personnel involved in fire and rescue services,  
3 including volunteers;
- 4 (iii) Purchasing:
  - 5 1. Fire and rescue equipment; or
  - 6 2. Real property to be used for fire and rescue services;
- 7 (iv) Constructing fire and rescue service buildings; and
- 8 (v) Making capital improvements to fire and rescue service  
9 facilities] FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICES.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11 July 1, 2006.
