1 (3)strategies to promote greater pedestrian activity and bicycle usage on 2 campus, including the establishment and enhancement of pedestrian and bicycle a determination of the convenience and accessibility of buses and 4 (4) 5 other mass transit facilities to persons using the campus; 6 (5) strategies to encourage carpooling; 7 recommendations on potential strategies, including roadway and 8 mass transit improvements, that might reduce vehicular traffic congestion on the campus; 10 (7) an assessment of the barriers to implementing roadway and mass 11 transit improvements and recommendations to address those barriers; and 12 recommendations regarding the funding amount required and the 13 funding mechanisms that might be utilized to improve traffic flow and reduce the amount of vehicular traffic on the campus. 15 During its deliberations, the University shall hold public hearings and 16 provide ample opportunity for public input. 17 The President and the Administration of the University of Maryland, 18 College Park shall submit a final report of the findings and recommendations 19 resulting from the study to the Governor and the House Environmental Matters 20 Committee and the Senate Finance Committee and, subject to § 2-1246 of the State 21 Government Article, to the members of the General Assembly on or before January 22 15, 2007. 23 (e) The Maryland Department of Transportation and Prince George's County 24 may not spend any funds or grant any approvals or permits for right-of-way 25 acquisition for, or the design or construction of, the proposed road known as the 26 Campus Connector at the University of Maryland, College Park until the final report required under this section is completed and submitted as specified under subsection 28 (d) of this section. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 29 30 July 1, 2006. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30,

31 2007, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be

32 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
