- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 21
- 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

THE DEPARTMENT SHALL: 3 (A) COORDINATE WITH THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION TO 4 5 DEVELOP A DATABASE THAT COMPARES THE NAMES OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE 6 APPLIED UNDER § 8 712 OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF A 7 CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER FOR A MOTORIZED VESSEL WITH THE NAMES OF 8 INDIVIDUALS WHOSE DRIVER'S LICENSE IS SUSPENDED OR REVOKED BY THE MOTOR 9 VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION: 10 (2)DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM TO REQUIRE OWNERS OF 11 MOTORIZED VESSELS TO OBTAIN AN AFFIDAVIT FROM ANY PERSON THE OWNER 12 ALLOWS TO OPERATE THE OWNER'S MOTORIZED VESSEL, INCLUDING ANY PERSON 13 TO WHOM THE OWNER RENTS, LEASES, OR LENDS THE VESSEL, CERTIFYING THAT 14 THE PERSON DOES NOT HAVE A DRIVER'S LICENSE THAT IS SUSPENDED OR 15 REVOKED BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION; AND DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM TO REQUIRE OWNERS OF 16 17 MOTORIZED VESSELS TO FORWARD TO THE DEPARTMENT ALL AFFIDAVITS 18 OBTAINED UNDER ITEM (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION. 19 THE DEPARTMENT. IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MOTOR VEHICLE 20 ADMINISTRATION, SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION. 21 8-738.1. 22 (a) A person may not: 23 (1) Operate a vessel recklessly or in a manner that may endanger 24 another or the property of another on a bay, creek, lake, river, or stream in the State; 25 or Come into a wharf or bathing shore recklessly or in a manner that 26 (2) may endanger a person or property. A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on 28 (b) 29 conviction is subject to: 30 FOR A FIRST CONVICTION, imprisonment [for] not exceeding 30 days (1) 31 or a fine of not less than \$25 and not exceeding \$200 or both; AND 32 (2) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION, IMPRISONMENT NOT 33 EXCEEDING 60 DAYS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR BOTH. 34 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 35 October 1, 2006.
