A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Correctional Officers' Retirement System - Membership**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Correctional Officers' Retirement
4 System; requiring the transfer of certain employer contributions to the
5 accumulation fund of the Correctional Officers' Retirement System; and
6 generally relating to membership in the Correctional Officers' Retirement
7 System.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

21 25-201.

22 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this subtitle applies
23 only to:

24 (1) correctional officers serving in any of the first six job classifications;
25 [and]

26 (2) security attendants at Clifton T. Perkins Hospital Center; AND

1 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL SERVING AS A CORRECTIONAL DIETARY,
2 MAINTENANCE, OR SUPPLY OFFICER.

3 (b) This subtitle does not apply to an employee of the Baltimore City Jail as of
4 June 30, 1991, who:

5 (1) became an employee of the Baltimore City Detention Center on July
6 1, 1991; and

7 (2) who did not elect to become a member of the Correctional Officers'
8 Retirement System on that date.

9 25-203.1.

10 FOR MEMBERS WHO TRANSFER FROM THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM OR
11 THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL TRANSFER
12 TO THE ACCUMULATION FUND OF THE CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT
13 SYSTEM THE EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS THAT WERE MADE TO THE EMPLOYEES'
14 PENSION SYSTEM OR THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM ON BEHALF OF THOSE
15 MEMBERS WHO TRANSFERRED, PLUS THE INTEREST EARNED ON THOSE
16 CONTRIBUTIONS THROUGH THE DATE OF TRANSFER.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 July 1, 2006.
