8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

9 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Health - General

11 13-301.

12 The Kidney Disease Program is a program in the Department for the purpose of 13 providing funding of kidney disease treatment for qualified individuals who elect to 14 enroll in the Program and agree to pay fees which are described in this subtitle.

15 13-311.

16 (a) The Department shall certify an individual as eligible for benefits under17 the Program if the Department determines that:

18 (1) The individual has chronic kidney disease as defined in the19 Commission's regulations; and

20 (2) The individual meets the residency, citizenship, and other 21 nonmedical eligibility requirements established by the Department.

22 (b) (1) The certification of an individual under this section shall be for a 23 period of 1 year.

24 (2) The certification is renewable after each 1-year period if the 25 individual meets the requirements of subsection (a) of this section.

27 (A) The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE

28 Department may <u>SHALL</u> require Program recipients to apply for eligibility in the

30 THE MEDICARE PART D PROGRAM within 60 days of notification to do so by the

33 FOR ELIGIBILITY IN THE MEDICARE PART B PROGRAM OR THE MEDICARE PART D

34 PROGRAM IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THE PROGRAM RECIPIENT HAS

35 <u>COMPARABLE INSURANCE COVERAGE.</u>
