- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article - Health - General

- 3 The Kidney Disease Program is a program in the Department for the purpose of
- 4 providing funding of kidney disease treatment for qualified individuals who elect to
- 5 enroll in the Program and agree to pay fees which are described in this subtitle.
- 6 13-311.
- 7 (a) The Department shall certify an individual as eligible for benefits under 8 the Program if the Department determines that:
- 9 (1) The individual has chronic kidney disease as defined in the 10 Commission's regulations; and
- 11 (2) The individual meets the residency, citizenship, and other
- 12 nonmedical eligibility requirements established by the Department.
